Welcome & Introductions – Robert Ato joined us the new Activities and Civic Service chair.

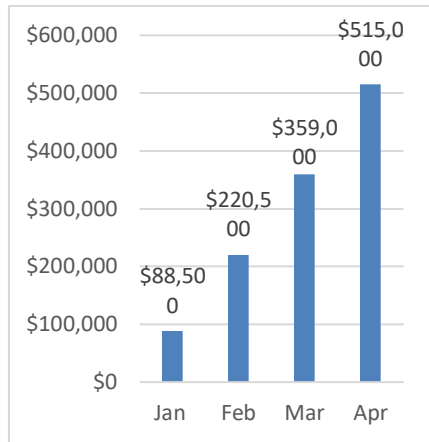
